Call for Abstracts July 2025

The AfricaGIS 2025 Conference, in collaboration with the United Nations Global Geospatial Information Management – Africa (UN-GGIM: Africa), invites abstract submissions from researchers, practitioners, policy makers, industry leaders, and students working in the geospatial field. The conference will be hosted in Accra, Ghana, from 17 to 21 November 2025, and will convene experts and stakeholders from across the continent and globally.

This joint conference will focus on how geospatial intelligence can be harnessed to drive Africa's sustainable development, climate resilience, digital transformation, and evidence-based governance, in alignment with Agenda 2063 and the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs).

## **Submission Guidelines:**

Abstracts should be **250-350 words**, clearly outlining the objectives, methodology, results (if applicable), and relevance to the chosen sub-theme. Authors **must** also include **three to four keywords** that reflect the core topics addressed in the abstract.

Submissions are welcome from all sectors: academia, public institutions, private sector, NGOs, youth, and development partners.

- Abstracts must be submitted in English
- All abstracts will be peer-reviewed.
- Submissions under the theme Oceans and Coastal Management will be eligible to be included in a special journal and an extended abstract will be requested.
